FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

RE: IN THE EVENT OF A STRIKE

- A hotline has been established to provide updates as they occur. Please check this hotline daily at:

(714) 740-6231

- There will be a Union presence to provide information as well.
- Pickets will be up 24 hours a day.
- If you are driving your route when the strike is called, finish your **trip** and return to the yard. Do not cross the picket line. Park the bus in a safe place and allow the base to retrieve it.
- Do not park your personal vehicle on company property. Park it in a safe place.
- Porta potties will be set up. Do not cross the picket line.
- Students and probationary employees are expected to honor the picket line.
- Coach Operators on light duty are expected to honor the picket line.
- Wear comfortable clothing. Wear Union apparel if possible.
- You are required to participate in labor activity in order to receive out of work benefits (i.e., picketing, phone banking and political and community mobilization).
- Out of work benefits are paid at four times the dues rate. Out of work benefits are payable at the end of the second week of the strike.
- Members on strike must pick up their own checks.
